MEMORIAL SHOOT

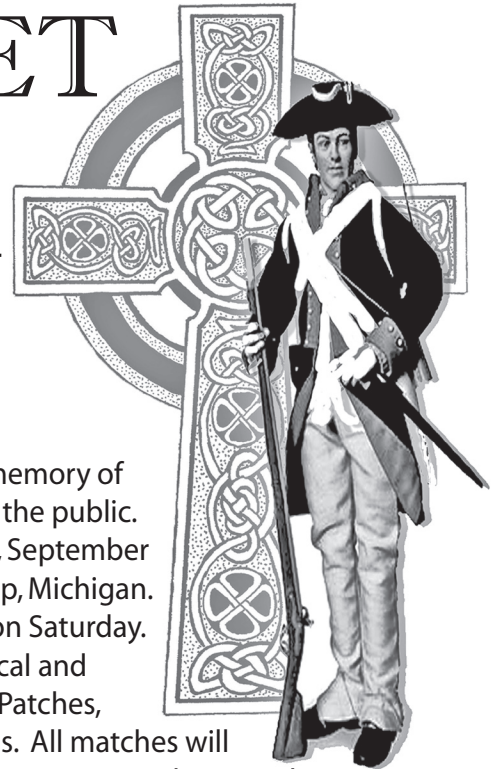
This three day muzzleloading event is held each year to honor the memory of those fellow muzzleloading enthusiasts that have passed on and is open to the public. The event will begin Friday September 17th, 2010 and run through Sunday, September 19th at the DSC's Delaney Park Primitive Range Complex in Shelby Township, Michigan.

Competition will begin with a flag raising and memorial ceremony on Saturday.

Shooting competition is open to all muzzleloading long-arms. Conical and jacketed bullets are permitted in modern In-lines and rifled-muskets. Polly-Patches, are not allowed. Sight-shades and scopes are not allowed on primitive arms. All matches will be loaded from pocket or pouch. Loading directly from horn, flask or can is not permitted. Eye and ear protection are required on the range at all times. Period, primitive dress is requested if you are shooting a traditional arm and points will be awarded for pre-1865 attire,... That includes Civil War costumes.

NMLRA rules are used unless noted. Range Officer's decisions are final. Camp sites are available. Wood and water will be provided.

Separate divisions for Traditional Rifles, Smoothbores (Tradeguns/Fowlers), Civil War Muskets and In-lines. There is no charge for traders or sutlers to camp if not shooting. Spectators are welcome.
