Starting Times: Practice at ≈ 9:00, 1st Match at ≈ 10:30 each day
Course of Fire: There will be two 40 shot matches each day with a short break between matches.
Rules: Current NRA Silhouette rules will apply.
DSC Rifle Range Rules will apply
Classification: The NRA classifications will be used. *2017 NRA scorebooks will be available and will be required to compete. Local classification books may be honored at the discretion of the Match Director, for classification purposes only.
Registration: These are squaddled matches. Pre-registration is recommended, but not required. Squadding requests will be honored on a first come, first served basis. Late entries will be accepted only if they do not require special squadding or additional relays. Entries will close at 9:30 each day.
Entry Fees: \$30.00 per competitor. Second rifle: \$20.00 Juniors \$15.00 & \$10.00
Awards: Awards will be based on the 80 shot aggregate scores. Awards will be for Match Winner and first in each class; however, if fewer than 5 entries in Master class, they will compete for Match Winner only. Additional class awards will be based on one award per 5 entries (i.e. 10 entries = 2 awards). Other awards may be presented per Match Director's bulletin based on pre-registration entries.
